1. The Tournament shall be conducted under the current rules of Lawn Tennis and the rules and regulations of Lawn Tennis Tournaments.
2. Players' behaviour both on and off court shall be in accordance with the LTA Code of Conduct and players shall wear tennis clothing.
3. Veterans must have reached the age of 35 by 1st January 2011.
4. Entries (using forms obtainable from your club organiser, club newsletter or by download from www.glasgowwestern.co.uk) close on Friday 10th September 2010. Entry fees are to be handed into the bar or gym staff with cheques made payable to "Western LT&SC".
5. All preliminary round matches (i.e. before quarter finals) shall comprise the best of two tiebreak sets and a championship tie-break (to 10). All quarter-final, semi-final and final matches shall comprise the best of three tie-break sets.
6. The tournament Committee reserve full powers to alter the programme in any way they may think proper, and to refuse entry without assigning reason. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event in which insufficient entries are received and to restrict entry if any event is over-subscribed.
7. Details of ties and results will be updated at the club and all results are to be supplied to the organiser or nominated substitute at the club or, in their absence, to the tournament referee.
8. All entrants should be available to play on the opening weekend (18th & 19th September)
9. Ties will not be rescheduled to meet individual availability. Competitors are responsible for checking when their ties are to be played.
10. The Babolat Team ball will be used for the tournament.
